

Sunday October 11th

I'm delighted that we will be back in the newly refurbished church interior this coming Sunday! On what will be a relaxed and happy family reunion we have a few common-sense rules of housekeeping to bear in mind, not a military-grade roll call! Seriously, there is absolutely nothing to be anxious about. The main church interior has been deep-cleaned, in addition to having been completely re-decorated.

For the Morning Service ALL that needs to be borne in mind is the following:

- 1) Numbers for the first Morning Service have been capped at 30 and that number has now been reached. A week on Sunday, availability will rise to 40 and, the following week, rise again to our maximum of 50. For every Sunday Service and for that matter, every week into the foreseeable future, you will need to book in advance.
- 2) If you are not able to attend a Sunday Morning Service after booking a place, please let us know.
- 3) Do not attend if you are displaying Covid-19 symptoms. Do not attend if you are not displaying Covid-19 symptoms but feel unwell.
- 4) If you were unable to get a place for the Morning Service, please bear in mind there will almost certainly be capacity for the Family Service in the afternoon. Why not attend that?
- 5) Please arrive in good time. When you do, come up the main church steps as per usual and into the foyer, where you will be required to sanitise hands and complete a track & trace registration. Try to prevent bunching together and unintentionally breaking the two-metre rule. We don't intend conducting temperature checks. You will need to wear a mask or face covering, such as a visor, throughout the entirety of the Service.
- 6) Stewards will be in attendance and you will be directed as to where to sit.
- 7) The Service will last for no more than 45 minutes and singing is not encouraged.
- 8) At the end of the Service you will need to leave via the side door opposite the Cottage and back out down the corridor to exit through the side entrance. This will ensure that we can maintain a one-way system.
- 9) Please meet up with friends after the Service - but, of course, not on church premises. As you know, there are plenty of places to meet in town, even on a Sunday!
- 10) For those worshipping at home, the Morning Service will continue to be live-streamed.

That's it! Nothing more (and perhaps even a little less) than what we are already getting used to in shops, cafes and other establishments. If in doubt, follow the person in front of you - well, perhaps not!

See you this Sunday! Or if not this Sunday, the Sunday after that.
